<b>Purpose of data processing</b>	Taking photographs and video recordings at the events for documentation, reporting and promotion of the Stipendium Hungaricum programme and TPF's internationalisation activities. Recordings may be published on TPF's websites, online platforms, social media channels and used at future TPF events.	
<b>Legal basis for data processing</b>	Data processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out by the Data Controller in the public interest in the field of Hungarian vocational training, education, and research and development, <b>Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR</b> . <i>An additional condition, pursuant to Section 2:48(1) of the Civil Code, is the Data Subject's voluntary consent to the creation and use of the recording.</i>	
<b>The personal data processed</b>	Likeness (photographs, video recordings) and any information directly discernible therefrom (e.g., name badge).	
<b>Persons authorized to access the data</b>	Personal data may be accessed by those employees and authorised contractors of TPF whose work requires access. All such persons have received data protection training and are bound by confidentiality obligations.	
<b>Retention period</b>	3 years from the date of the event. After expiry, recordings will be removed from surfaces under TPF's direct control and shall no longer be used in active communications. Note: TPF cannot guarantee removal from surfaces not under its direct control (e.g., content shared by third parties, internet archives).or until the Data Subject successfully objects.	
<b>Data Subject rights</b>	<p>The <b>Data Subject may object at any time</b> to data processing based on the legal ground necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest by sending a message to the Data Controller's email address.</p> <p>The Data Subject may request <b>access</b> to their personal data from the Data Controller, <b>request the erasure of their data, the restriction of data processing, the rectification of their data</b>, etc. (for more details: GDPR, Articles 12–23).</p> <p>TPF shall provide the requested information to the Data Subject in writing, primarily by electronic means, as soon as possible, but no later than one month from the receipt of the request.</p> <p>As a Data Subject, you may also file a complaint against TPF's data processing with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (1363 Budapest, P.O. Box 9; <a href="http://www.naih.hu">www.naih.hu</a>; <a href="mailto:ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu">ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu</a> ) or bring a legal action before a court to enforce your rights.</p>
